Regulations on IBA Young Lawyers' Committee National Representatives

1. Mission

The mission of National Representatives is to promote communication between young IBA members within a jurisdiction and the Young Lawyers Committee of the IBA (hereinafter referred to as "YLC"), thereby strengthening the links among national and local young lawyers associations and the international community.

The position of a National Representative is not a formal function under the IBA regulations, it is a position established by the YLC in order to promote the interests of young IBA members within the jurisdiction of each National Representative.

2. Number of National Representatives per jurisdiction

The YLC, represented by its officers, shall have the right to nominate up to three National Representatives for each country upon application.

3. Application procedure

Any member of the YLC who is interested to serve as a National Representative for his or her jurisdiction shall submit to the YLC's National Representative Officer an application form which can be found on the YLC website. Each applicant shall also submit a CV and letter of interest. Close ties to national bars or young lawyers associations will be considered an asset.

By submitting his or her application each applicant agrees to the terms of the officership, including meeting the duties contained in Article 5 of this Regulation.

4. Term of office

The term of office of a National Representative shall be two years, starting as of January 1st of the year following his/her nomination.

The term may be extended subject to completion of the renomination procedures by two years at the expiration of the initial term upon request. The term may be terminated before expiry of the regular term in accordance with Article 6 of this Regulation by declaration of the Chairman of the YLC. Such declaration shall be based on a decision of the YLC (simple majority of votes is required).

5. Duties

5.1 General Duties

National Representatives shall have the duty to foster the interests of IBA and YLC in terms of Article 1 of this Regulation.

Furthermore, National Representatives shall refrain from any action which might endanger IBA's or YLC's reputation or credibility or the quality of their work. The same applies to any actions which might impede the achievement of the aims of IBA and YLC.

National Representatives are not allowed to use the intellectual property of the IBA, especially IBA logos, for personal means. The use for personal means comprises the use in National Representatives' day-to-day business and any other private or commercial correspondence or presentations of National Representatives. In cases of doubt, the National Representatives shall communicate the anticipated usage to the Chairman of the YLC and obtain the IBA's written approval before making use of any IBA intellectual property. If the use of the IP is considered essential to the performance of a National Representative's duties, the Chairman of the YLC may request that the IBA approve use of the intellectual property on behalf of and in his/her name. The IBA shall have the right in its sole discretion to approve use of IBA intellectual property by the National Representative. In the event that the request is rejected by the IBA or YLC, the National Representative shall have no claims against the IBA, YLC, its representatives or other involved parties.

5.2 Specific Duties

Each National Representative shall have the specific duties listed below:

6. Right to Withdraw the Nomination

YLC reserves the right to withdraw National Representatives' nominations (simple majority of votes required) in the event a nominated National Representative fails to perform his/her duties (in particular those duties set out in Article 5) at any time during the term. The same applies

- a) on grounds of legitimate suspicions that a National Representative failed to perform his/her duties; or
- b) in case of any other severe misconduct of the National Representative.

The National Representative shall be heard prior to the withdrawal or early termination of his/her nomination. In case of early termination or withdrawal of the nomination, the National Representative shall have no claims against YLC, its representatives or other involved parties.

7. Others

The Chairman of the YLC may delegate his/her responsibilities under this Regulations to any other officer of the YLC.
