## Criteria

- (1) *The Jack Batievsky Scholarship to attend the Biennial IBA Latin American Regional Forum Conference from 19–21 March 2025 is free to enter. It is open to all lawyers up to and including the age of 35, practicing in a Latin American country, whether they are members of the IBA or not.*
- (2) *Applications should be written in English and be accompanied by a 2,500 word paper on the following topic:*  
**How can law firms make the best use of AI and what should be the policies when using it?**  
*Papers must be original, unpublished works. They will not be under consideration for any Commercial Contract by any publishing house. The author is warranting his/her restricted copyright to the paper submitted.*
- (3) *The word paper shall not have the name of the applicant printed on it, to ensure that the members of the judging committee do not have access to the names of the applicants during the decision process. The name of the applicant should be indicated only in the corresponding email, but not in the attached word paper. The IBA office in São Paulo will identify the applicants by a number and will keep the names of the applicants undisclosed, until the judging committee reaches a decision.*
- (4) *Applications must be submitted and received by **2 DECEMBER 2024**. Applications received after this time will not be considered.*
- (5) *All applications will be submitted to the Scholarship Committee which will consist of IBA Latin American Regional Forum Officers. They will judge the papers primarily on the basis of legal argumentation, research, style, logic, originality and overall quality of the content.*
- (6) *It is planned that the IBA Office will communicate the conference selection panel decision to the successful applicants by **10 JANUARY 2025**.*
- (7) *The decision of the judging committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The decision will be published on the IBA website. The successful applicants will be contacted at the email address given on the application form.*
- (8) *The Scholarship Award includes:*
  - *Free registration for the Biennial IBA Latin American Regional Forum Conference, 19–21 March 2025, Lima, Peru, including social events;*
  - *A contribution towards travel and accommodation costs to the conference; and*
  - *Free registration for the Annual IBA Latin American Regional Forum Young Lawyers' Training Programme, 19 March 2025, Lima, Peru (optional)*
- (9) *The completed application form must be returned by email by **2 DECEMBER 2024** to: Flavia Alves, International Bar Association, email: **flavia.alves@int-bar.org***
- (10) *Each participant may submit only one application. Employees of the IBA or officers of any IBA committee are excluded from entering.*
- (11) *The IBA or the Scholarship Committee and the organisers of the scholarship are not responsible for the loss, damage or non-arrival, nor for any costs or expenses incurred in the preparation or the submission of your application.*
- (12) *Please note if you are awarded a scholarship you will be required to confirm your attendance by providing a copy of your travel documents for your accommodation to be booked and visa letter issued (should you need to apply for one). These documents must be sent to Flavia Alves (**flavia.alves@int-bar.org**) by **24 JANUARY 2025**.*
- (13) *The IBA has the right to publish a selection of the papers submitted, including but not limited to the winning papers (either the full text or extracts thereof) up to 18 months after the competition has ended; this includes but is not limited to the publication in the conference documentation and/or on the IBA website and/or other IBA publications. In any event, the name of the author will be indicated appropriately. Authors shall include a biographical note giving details of their legal career, studies and professional appointments. Papers received that are not in this form may not be considered.*
- (14) *If you are awarded a scholarship please note that proficiency in English is mandatory and you will be required to provide evidence that you are able to practise law.*
- (15) *Participants will be expected to have read and accepted all the above rules.*
