We have the honour to inform you that your communication initially submitted on 22 September 2022, which you submitted to the Human Rights Committee for consideration under the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights on behalf of Mr. Anatole Nsengiyumva and Mr. Andre Ntagerura, has been registered as communication No. 4227/2022. You are kindly asked to refer to this registration number in any future correspondence. Interim Measures

Under rule 94 of the Committee's rules of procedure, the State party has also been requested to refrain from deporting authors to Rwanda, while their communication is under consideration by the Committee. This request does not imply that any decision has been reached on the substance of the matter under consideration.

Registration of the case

In correspondence with rule 92 of the Committee's rules of procedure, a copy of the communication has been transmitted to the State party today, with the request that any information or observations in respect of both the question of admissibility and the merits of your communication should reach the Committee within six months. Any reply from the State party will be communicated to you in due course to enable you to comment thereon, if you so wish.

Confidentiality

Please be aware that final decisions adopted by the Human Rights Committee are made public. Therefore, if the authors wish for their identity not be disclosed in the final decision, you are kindly requested to so indicate as soon as possible. Kindly note that, due to the level of publicity the Committee's decisions usually receive (including
