U.S. WHISTLEBLOWER Reward Programs

A monetary incentive offered by U.S. government & its agencies to individuals in exchange for their valuable assistance in exposing wrongdoing otherwise difficult to detect

7 MAIN U.S. WHISTLEBLOWER REWARD PROGRAMS – FEDERAL (1 OF 2)



1863/1986 FALSE CLAIMS ACT: Foundation of U.S. whistleblower reward system. Whistleblowers report fraud in federal government contracts and programs. 31 states and 8 cities have FCAs.

2006 Incentivizes people to report evasion, underreporting, and other U.S. tax law violations. 2010 Encourages those with knowledge of violations of U.S. securities laws or bribery of foreign government officials to share this information with the SEC. 2010 Encourages those with knowledge of violations of the U.S. Commodity Exchange Act to share this information.

7 MAIN U.S. WHISTLEBLOWER REWARD PROGRAMS - FEDERAL (2 OF 2)



2015

Encourages those with knowledge of vehicle safety violations to share this information with the DOT. 2021 <u>KLEPTOCRACY ASSET</u> <u>RECOVERY</u>: Encourages those with knowledge of stolen assets linked to foreign government corruption to share this information with the Treasury Department 2021 & 2022 <u>FINCEN</u>: JAN. 2021: Encourages those w/ knowledge of violations of U.S. Bank Secrecy Act/money laundering to share this info w/ Treasury Department. <u>DEC. 2022</u>: Program expanded to include violations of U.S. sanctions laws.

STATE & LOCAL FALSE CLAIMS ACTS State Medicaid fraud **Procurement fraud**

Allows private persons, known as relators, to bring qui tam lawsuits on the government's behalf, with the promise of a potential reward of between 15% and 30% of any fines imposed by the government.




1987-2022 DOJ (FALSE CLAIMS ACT)

Total amount of whistleblower awards to 397 individuals.




Total recovery due to whistleblower tips as of 2022



Proceeds collected as a result of whistleblower informant tips






Total amount of whistleblower awards Whistleblower awards percentage of total proceeds recovered
