VENTURA CARRASCO TOWER

FERRERE advises Ventura Carrasco Tower, which in addition to after-occupancy efficiency in energy, is focused in reducing the footprint during construction, with most that 80% of construction waste materials recycled (more than 50 tons so far). Those recycled materials are processed to create isolating panels, used in the tower.

COASTLINE PROTECTION: First 150 meters from the shoreline measured towards the interior of the territory are protected, any project shall consider the protection of the coastline and will ensure accessibility. In addition, will avoid the formation of continuous buildings parallel to the coast in the rest of the strip. Any project involving this strip will need special authorizations.

National System of Protected Natural Areas (*Sistema Nacional de Areas Protegidas - "SNAP"*),

Prohibition of certain activities to be carried within these areas (i.e. Forestry, Windfarms).

Activities, constructions and works to be performed within a SNAP for which a management plan has not been yet to be approved, must obtain prior Environmental Authorization.
