Negotiating tools for the protection of luxury brands. Selective distribution networks and recent developments before Italian and French courts

For many years, the principles of exhaustion of trademarks, as well as the free movement of goods, represented an obstacle to the enforcement of selective distribution networks against sales made by non-authorized distributors. More than ever, the economic crisis resulting from the pandemic highlights the importance for manufacturers to effectively protect their selective distribution networks against grey market distributors.

During this session, we will discuss the industry needs in these challenging times and analyse the implications of the most recent Italian and French case-law on selective distribution networks also considering the European debate around the review of the Block Exemption Regulation (EU) no. 330/2010.

Environmental, Social, Governance (ESG) The evolution of companies in Italy and France moving towards positive Economy

Sustainability is not an option anymore for companies and is becoming strategic to long term development and attractiveness to investors and human capital. Besides the mandatory compliance programmes provided by local regulations, national legislations in Italy and France have introduced new corporate tools to allow companies, on a voluntary basis, to change paradigm, shifting from a shareholders' value towards a stakeholders' value; the session will examine, *inter alia*, the French and Italian regulations on the subject matter on a comparative basis (Loi Pacte and société à Mission in France, Benefit company in Italy), the key role of measurement of non-financial performance and the growing importance of ESG for law firms and companies.

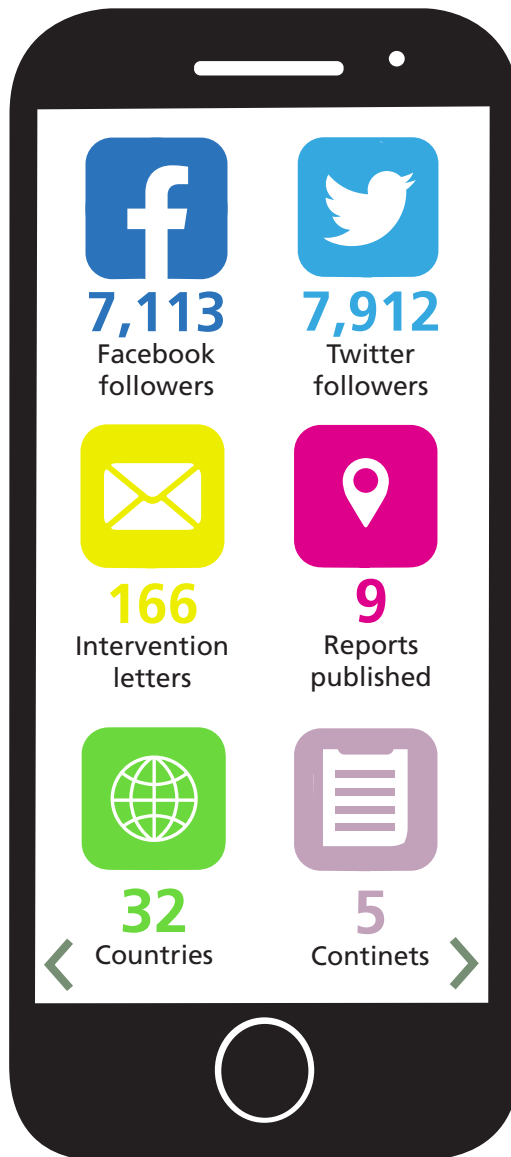
