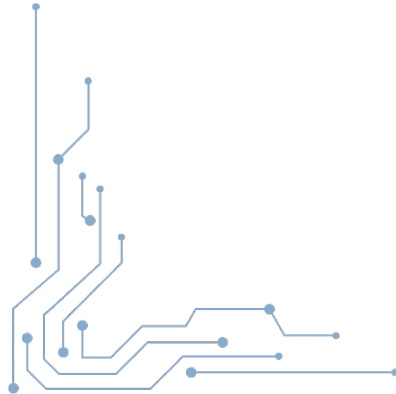

Artificial Intelligence – Overview

Artificial Intelligence is a field of science concerned with building computers and machines that can reason, learn, and act in a way that would normally require human intelligence.

The Present

AI is currently considered “**Weak**”, performing only narrow sets of actions based on its programming or training (e.g. image recognition, chatbots).



The Future:

“**General Intelligence**” is the next level, which will enable a machine to “**sense, think and act**” like a human.

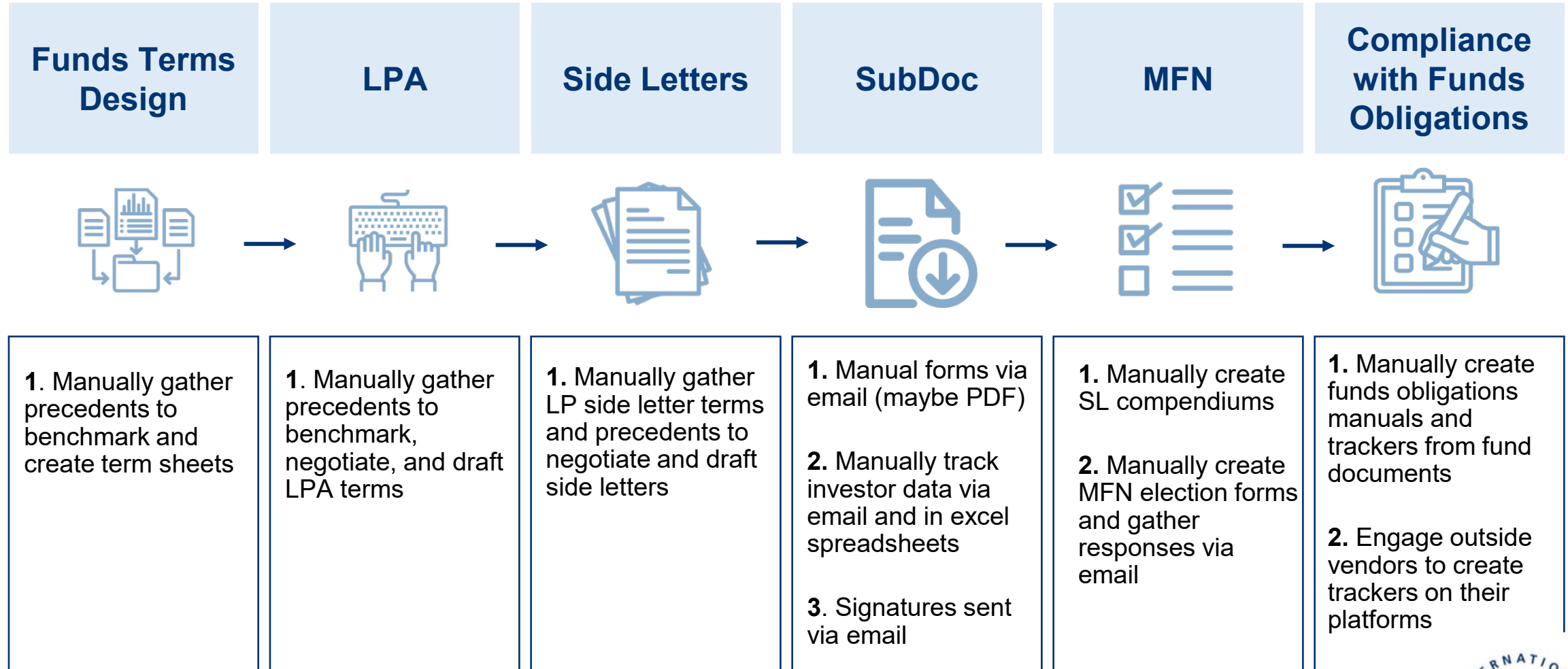

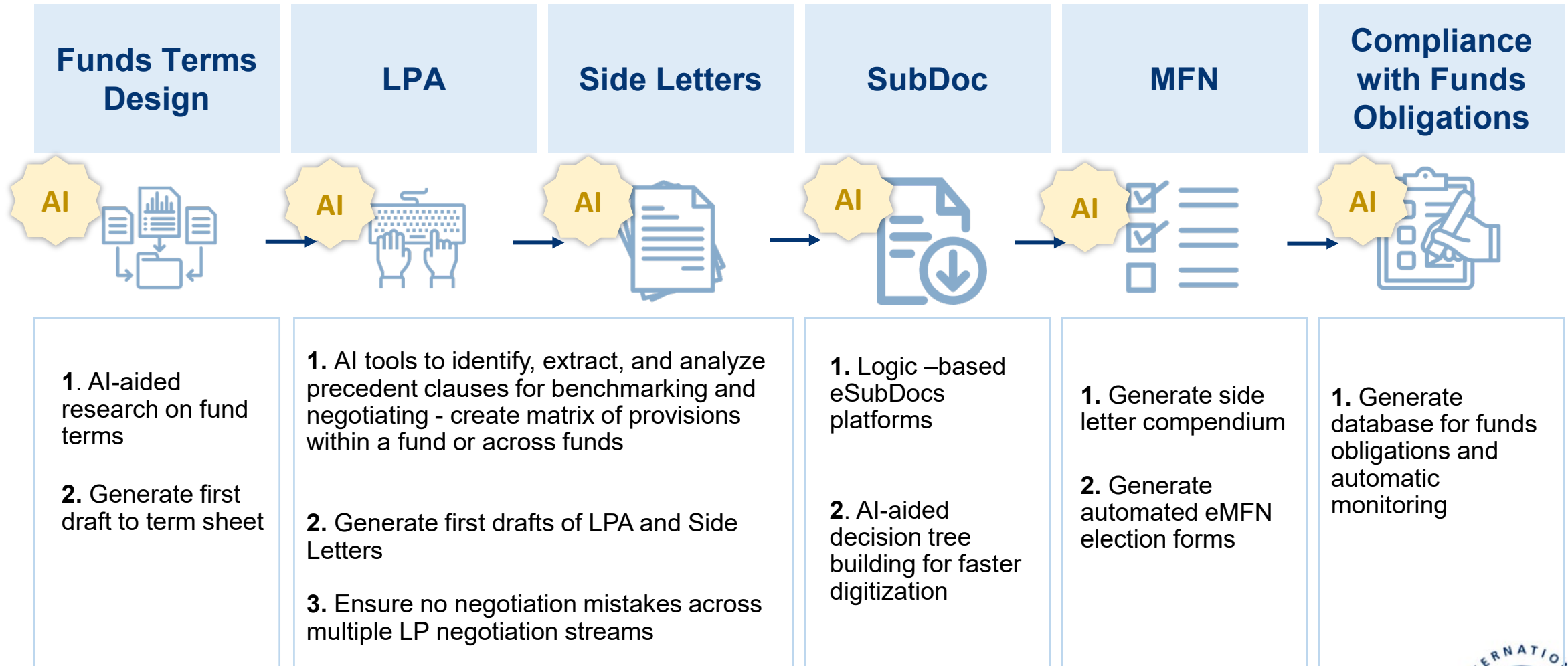
Funds Technology and Fund Launch Workflow
