TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Nominees will be considered on the following criteria:
 - Achieved professional excellence in her field;
 - Influenced other women to pursue legal careers;
 - Opened doors for women lawyers in a variety of job settings that historically were closed to them; and
 - Advanced opportunities for women within their practice area or segment of the profession.
- 2. There is a separate form for the nominator and a separate form for the nominee. Please ensure you coordinate the submission of both these forms in time for the deadline.
- 3. The award is free to enter. It is open to all lawyers, whether or not they are members of the IBA.
- 4. Employees of the IBA, Officers of any IBA entity and relatives of the above are excluded from the competition.
- 5. Previous winners of the award are also excluded from the competition.
- 6. The Award winner is selected by the Women Lawyers' Judging Panel.
- 7. By entering the award all nominators and nominees consent to all data they submit on this form being shared with the Judging Panel.
- 8. Nominations must be submitted and received by MIDNIGHT (BST) SUNDAY 20 JUNE 2021. Nominations received after this time will not be considered.



- 9. The winner, as part of the award, will also receive the following:
 - a choice of free registration to one of the following conferences; IBA Annual Conference in Miami on 30 October 04 November 2022 OR the 9th World Women Lawyers' Conference September 2021.
 - a contribution towards accommodation and travel costs to attend the conference;
 - one years' free membership of the IBA and Women Lawyers' Interest Group
- 10. All complete received nominations will be reviewed by the Judging Panel. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 11. The winner will be contacted at the email address provided on the form. They will be required to provide a biographical note giving details of their legal career, studies and professional appointments.
- 12. The IBA will contact all other candidates via his/her nominator(s) to notify him/her of the unsuccessful outcome of his/her nomination. This will be done by email as soon as the Judging Panel has selected the winner.
- 13. The IBA will publicise the winner's details on the IBA website and in promotional communications.
- 14. The IBA, the Women Lawyers' Interest Group, LexisNexis and the judging panel are not responsible for the loss, damage or non-arrival of any nomination form, nor for any costs or expenses incurred in the preparation or the submission of any form.
