

The National Agency on Corruption Prevention

- identified over 13 thousands of individuals and over 4 thousands of companies against which sanctions should be imposed
- develops the main database of sanctions that were imposed due to Russia's attack on Ukraine





The National Agency on Corruption Prevention



coordinates the **compliance officers** working in public institutions, state- and municipally-owned enterprises



monitors corruption risks in draft laws and acts of the Government



ensure the **security** of its information resources, in particular the register of declarations

The National Agency on Corruption Prevention

works on risk assessment and corruption prevention in humanitarian aid

proposes **solutions** on optimal needs identification system for distribution of humanitarian aid
